Dobson Place Community Association

Please be advised of a current proposal before the City of Chandler Planning and Zoning Commission that will impact the community. A developer, Starpointe Communities, is seeking to change the zoning of the vacant land known as Norton's Crossing located on the **NW corner of Chandler Blvd. and Gilbert Road.** Currently, the zoning is PAD Commercial (C-2) and the proposed change is for PAD Commercial <u>with underlying Multi-family (MF-2) zoning</u>.

If successful, the developer will build retail shops and retail office space along Gilbert Road and Chandler Blvd. This site will be anchored by a grocery store. Additionally, if the change in zoning is successful, Starpointe will build <u>two and three story apartment buildings BEHIND the retail complex</u>. A total of 374 one and two bedroom apartments are proposed. <u>This site will require 935 parking spaces</u>, many of which will be within 15 feet of our neighbors' property.

Studies about the impact of multi-family housing on property values have been inconclusive and todate no studies have been completed in Arizona. However, we know a record number of foreclosures are tightening the mortgage market, the number of MLS listings in Arizona is at an all-time high, and property values across the valley are down. *Will you and your neighbors in Dobson Place let this avoidable threat affect your property values*? The change in zoning for this proposal is critical. <u>Without the change to multi-</u> family zoning, the developers have said they would have no reason to continue with the project.
