In the annual meeting notice and ballot, we posed a few questions for your consideration. Here are the results:

Question 1:

"Would you like to see a Volley Ball Court replace one of our smaller playgrounds within the community?" Answer:

44% want to convert one of the tot lots into a volleyball court.

Question 2:

"Do you feel you are receiving value for your association assessment?"

Answer:

77% of respondents feel they are getting their money's worth.

Assessments Remain the Same Four Years Running

The year 2013 has again proven to be both a challenging and highly satisfying year for your Dobson Place Homeowner's Association. Your Board of Directors has continued our focus on maintaining the quality of life in our community while simultaneously managing the current costs and expenses, as well as financial planning for our future.

Your Board of Directors is extremely pleased to announce the good news for 2014. Our quarterly assessments will remain \$127.00 per quarter. This will be the 4th consecutive year the quarterly assessments will be \$127.00. Our assessments will continue to be collected quarterly with assessments due on the first day of each calendar quarter beginning January 1, 2014.

While maintaining stable quarterly assessments, your Board of Directors has also positioned our community well to meet the ongoing asset repair and capital replacement costs in the future. An updated Reserve Study was completed in May, 2013. This study identifies and quantifies future assets replacement costs (playground equipment, block walls, granite, etc.). The Boards enhanced focus for the last few years on increasing our monthly reserve contributions has been successful. Based on the updated Reserve Study, for the first time ever, your Dobson Place Homeowner's Association will be fully funded for the near term asset replacement costs. The fully funded reserve minimizes the likelihood that any special assessment for asset replacement will occur in the near term.

Although this is great news for the community as a whole some of our neighbor homeowners continue to face personal financial challenges. The Homeowner's Association recognizes these individual financial challenges occur regardless of the broader economic circumstances in our state and country. The Board strongly encourages those homeowners who may be encountering some temporary financial challenge to reach out the board to see in if any alternate payment options are available regarding payment of your quarterly assessments.

City of Chandler Christmas Tree Recycling Information

Christmas Tree Recycling takes place between Dec. 26-Jan 17. Christmas trees collected are chipped and reused in park landscaping projects.

For safety, please remove: Tree stands, nails, ornaments, garland, lights. DO NOT place tree in bag.

Curbside Christmas Tree Collection

Tree must be out for collection by 6 a.m.. on your recycle day. Place tree at the end of your property, no more than 4 ft. behind the sidewalk. Driver cannot go more than 4 ft. on your property to retrieve the tree.

DO NOT place tree in can, on sidewalk, street or alley.
